The Baptist Humanitarian Action Course is hosted by the Baptist Forum for Aid and Development (BFAD) and the Asia Pacific Baptist Federation (APBF). This is a four-day intensive regional Humanitarian Course programme designed to equip Baptist leaders, church workers, and local aid practitioners to respond more effectively and safely to disasters and community needs.

Tailored for beginners to those with more advanced experience in the humanitarian aid sector, the training will cover biblical foundations for relief work, community disaster planning, project management, regional coordination and contemporary issues like climate change that impact disasters in the region.
